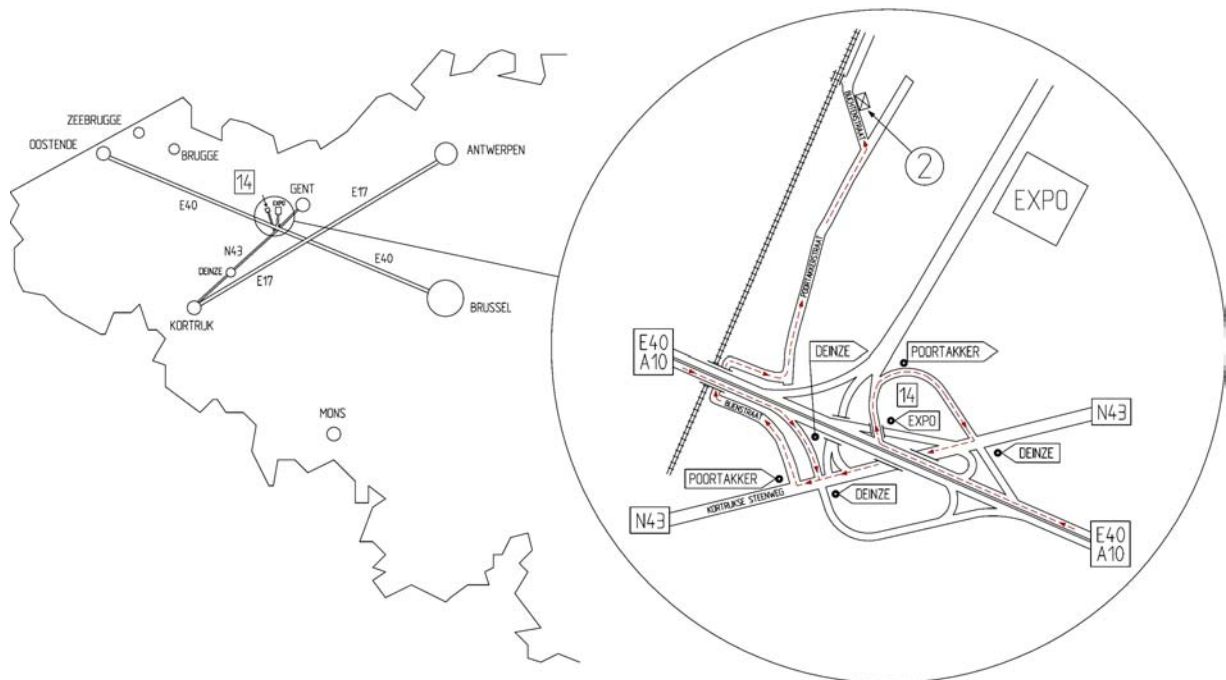


Please find below directions to reach AutoJet Technologies, Gent:

**Travel by CAR:**

- ❖ AutoJet Technologies is located near the crossing of the E17 (Amsterdam-Paris) and the E40 (Liege-Brussels-Ostend) motorways: along motorway E40 BRUSSEL-OOSTENDE follow direction EXPO and take EXIT 14.
- ❖ Attention: IN this exit follow direction 'DEINZE'.
- ❖ At the end of the exit turn right on the N43, direction DEINZE.
- ❖ Attention: turn immediately right again (this is the very first street on your right, immediately next to the E40 entry/exit and right behind the rental car company "DOCKX").
- ❖ You are now in the "Bijenstraat / Poortakkerstraat". You will soon see the 'AutoJet' panels.
- ❖ Follow this road for about 1km. This road makes a U-turn under the freeway and you will soon meet some authentic Flemish cobblestones.
- ❖ At the end of the cobblestones, turn left and after 150m you will see the AutoJet T building on your right.

### **Travel by TAXI from airport:**

- ❖ Cost of airport shuttle/taxi (one way) - 3000 BEF or 75 Euro

### **Travel by TRAIN from airport or Brussels train stations:**

There are several trains per hour from BRUSSELS NATIONAL AIRPORT to GENT SINT PIETERS. But there is also at least 1 DIRECT train every hour. A direct train means that you don't need to switch trains in Brussels (this increases your chances of making it to Gent), just stay on the train, but get off at the right station. Gent Sint Pieters is the name for the Gent main station - just 5 minutes by car/taxi to the company/hotel.

During weekdays: 2 direct trains every hour.

- ❖ The train of 48 minutes past the hour (hh:48) makes it in 57 minutes to Gent.
- ❖ The train of 3 minutes past the hour (hh:03) makes it in 1 hour and 25 minutes to Gent. This train makes several extra stops.

On Saturdays: 1 direct train every hour.

- ❖ The train of 3 minutes past the hour (hh:03) takes 1 hour and 25 minutes to get you to Gent. This train makes several stops.

On Sundays: 1 direct train every hour.

- ❖ The train of 32 minutes past the hour (hh:32) takes 1 hour and 25 minutes to get you to Gent. This train makes several stops.

- ❖ For Departure Station type: BRUSSEL NAT LUCHTHAVEN (this is the airport station)
- ❖ For Destination Station type: GENT SINT PIETERS (this is the main station in Gent)
